HAVE YOU THOUGHT ABOUT BECOMING AN ELECTORAL RECORDS OFFICER?

Every year the council has a legal duty to undertake a canvass of households over the autumn and produce a revised Register of Electors by 1 December which lists all the people registered to vote within the district.

Electoral Records Officers are employed from mid-September until the end of January throughout the district to call on residents who have not returned their household enquiry form, and if necessary, to help them complete the form. It is expected that most of the work will need to be done during the evenings and weekends. This work can also be done in your spare time, alongside a full-time job.

The canvass is currently scheduled to start in September 2017 and training will take place for this work prior to the canvass starting.
