PUBLIC SPEAKING SESSION (max 10 minutes)

There is an opportunity for members of the public to speak on matters which affect the Council or Committee at the beginning of the meeting when a maximum of 10 minutes is allowed. If you wish to attend and speak, please note the following:

- Any resident of the Parish may ask to speak during the Public Speaking Session;
- Only one person can speak on any given topic at any meeting;
- The normal time allowed will be up to 10 minutes, but the chairman may vary this depending on the number of speakers wishing to address the council;
- The Councillors undertake to listen to the speaker, and may ask questions for clarification; it does not undertake to answer questions raised during the same session;
- The more notice given, the more specific any questions are and the more clearly an issue is described, the more likely it is that the Council will be able to provide an answer;
- Any written materials available can be submitted at least 24 hours before the meeting to the Clerk for circulation to Councillors
